TODAY- Our own **Damian DeDonatis** will speak about the “World of Body Building”.

NEXT WEEK- Keith Davidson, of the Relay For Life program will be the speaker. The topic will be: Imagine A World With More Birthdays. This program is being arranged by Claudia McLaughlin.

LAST WEEK- Jayne Steubing introduced PDG Anne Cargile who spoke about the National Immunization Day in Nigeria. In November 2008 Anne and 13 others flew to Nigeria. While there riots broke out and 350 people died when mosques and churches were destroyed. It was necessary for the Americans to hide from rioters and, when driving, never stop because of bandits. They had to convince tribal leaders that they were not sterilizing their children and of the value of the vaccine. While there, these 13 Rotarians immunized 7,000 children and 1.5 million kids where immunized nationwide. Anne noted that polio remains endemic in only four countries- Afghanistan, India, Nigeria, and Pakistan. Currently it costs 60 cents per dose and 3 doses are required to immunize each child. Rotary has a \$200 million dollar challenge 2008-2012. The Bill and Melinda Gates foundation has awarded a \$350 million dollar grant if Rotary meets this goal. Anne noted that since December 2007, Scotia Rotary has given the most in the district, \$9,165. Please remember this foundation in giving this year and every year to help reach our goal.

PP Wayne Andrews mentioned there was still fruit available and please turn in all monies so that he can wrap up this fundraiser.

A little trivia- On Sunday, March 14, 2010 at 2 a.m., Daylight Saving Time begins in the United States.

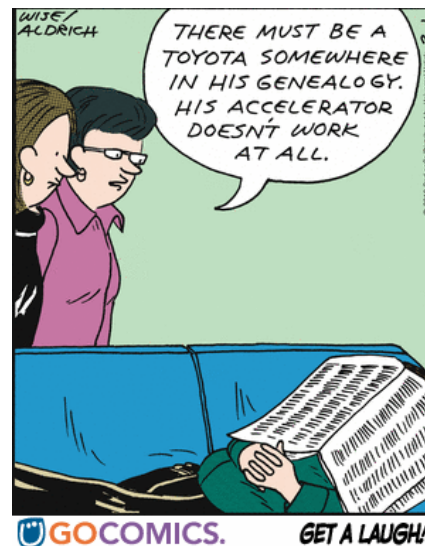
The change to Daylight Saving Time allows us to use less energy in lighting our homes by taking advantage of the longer and later daylight hours. During the eight month period of Daylight Saving Time, the names of time in each of the time zones in the U.S. change as well. Eastern Standard Time (EST) becomes Eastern Daylight Time, Central Standard Time (CST) becomes Central Daylight Time (CDT), Mountain Standard Time (MST) becomes Mountain Daylight Time (MDT), Pacific Standard Time becomes Pacific Daylight Time (PDT), and so forth.
